#### Background

There are rules and regulations across Australia governing the visible light transmittance (VLT) for all windows and windscreens on cars. Installing One Way Vision onto your vehicle will affect the VLT rating of your vehicle. If a non-complying film is found to be on a car, the police or transport department can issue a defect notice and a fine. In addition, if the car is involved in an accident, the insurance company may act against the car owner or not pay a claim.

AutoVue has been independently tested by the CSIRO for its VLT rating. When properly installed and maintained in accordance with our instructions, AutoVue VLT rating complies with all relevant regulations. AutoVue complies due to the larger hole size and a higher number of holes per square metre. Other One Way Vision films may claim compliance, but they cannot supply to you an independent report verifying compliance. This maybe because those films have smaller holes and less holes per square metre.

Play it safe and legal, use AutoVue for cars such as sedans, wagons, SUVs, 4WDs, utes, hatch backs.

### Specify AutoVue

We suggest you **specify Clear Focus One Way Vision AutoVue** for the sign/printing company to use on your next vehicle signage project. We recommend overlaminating AutoVue **with CurvaLam**, as this will help the driver to see out through the film when it rains.
